## Terms and Conditions for Braund Fostering Hope Scholarship Applicants

The Braund Fostering Hope Scholarship provides scholarships to TAFE SA students.

#### 1. The Scholarship structure:

- The Scholarship will provide financial assistance while studying at TAFE SA;
- Scholarships are awarded to applicants who, at the absolute discretion of the Trustee, have fulfilled the selection criteria;
- Each Scholarship is for the duration of the course for which the recipient is awarded;
- Students maintaining subsequent enrolments in more advanced courses through to Degree may continue receiving the scholarship during the term of the scholarship period (initial 18 month term) at the discretion of the Trustee.
- The maximum scholarship payment will be \$1500 per annum, \$750 payable per semester, depending on the duration of the enrolment. Once enrolment ceases the scholarship is no longer payable.

#### 2. To be eligible for a Scholarship, applicants must meet the following selection criteria:

• be Australian citizens or have permanent Australian resident status;

- be enrolled in an eligible course at TAFE SA;
- complete and submit the application form provided by TAFE SA;
- attest that they are not in receipt of any other scholarship valued in excess of \$500 in total at the time of application; and
- meet one or more of the Scholarship Priority Criteria (tick box above) and
- provide evidence of:
  - a commitment to study;
  - demonstrated financial hardship; and
  - a personal statement regarding their background, personal circumstances and aspirations;

#### 3. Administration of Scholarships:

- Shortlisting of eligible Scholarship Recipients will be conducted by a Selection Panel comprising at least three representatives from TAFE SA Staff.
- The Panel will assess shortlisted applicants and then forward recommendations to the Trustee, who will approve recipients to receive scholarships. The Trustee's decision is final.
- TAFE SA will notify all applicants, in writing, of the outcome of their application.
- All information supplied to Panel Members, Counselling and Inclusion and Administration Officers and the Trustee is treated as confidential.
- All signed Scholarship Applications will be evidence of the applicant's acceptance of the terms and conditions as set out by the Trustee; including consent to their names and personal details being provided to the Trustee for the purposes of distributing the Funds and possible invitation to social events, however, specific consent will be sought for any publicity which identifies individual Scholarship Recipients.
