


1. In the search bar next to the Windows button type **WiFi** and click **Wi-Fi settings**





2. Click on **Manage known networks**



3. Click on **Add a new network**



4. Enter the following details:

- Network Name: **eduroam**
- Security Type: **WPA2-Enterprise AES**
- EAP method: **Protected EAP (PEAP)**
- Authentication method: **Secured password (EAP-MSCHAP v2)**
- Check Connect automatically if you want your computer to connect every time it is within range of the eduroam wireless network




6. Repeat Steps 1 and 2, and click **Show available networks**





7. Click on **eduroam** and press connect




8. Sign in using your TAFE SA email address and password, and press **OK**
