TAFE SA Orientation Program: Getting Ready Checklist

Be Prepared for your studies at TAFE SA. The Getting Ready Checklist can help you get ready before classes start.

What do I need?

- Pen and notebook
- Suitable clothes for the weather and safety
- Transport arranged to get to campus (if you are studying onsite)
- Lunch or refreshment, especially if you are going to be onsite for long days

- Online access. Whether you are studying online or on-campus, it is likely that you will need to have easy access to a computer or internet. If you don't have a computer at home, consider your options to use your local campus or library to get access to computers for your studies
- A quiet space to study. Think about creating a spot in your home, if possible, away from distractions. Alternatively, find a place on a campus or community library
