Terms and Conditions for VEOLIA Scholarship Fund Applicants

The VEOLIA Scholarship Fund provides annual Scholarships to TAFE SA students.

1. The Scholarship structure:

- The Scholarship will provide financial assistance while studying at TAFE SA;
- Scholarships are awarded to worthy applicants who, at the absolute discretion of Veolia, have fulfilled the selection criteria;
- Each scholarship is for the academic year in which it is awarded;
- The amount of payment will be determined by Veolia.

2. To be eligible for a Scholarship, applicants must:

- be Australian citizens or have permanent Australian resident status;
- be enrolled in an eligible course at TAFE SA;
- complete and submit the application form provided by TAFE SA;
- attest that they are not in receipt of any other scholarship valued in excess of \$500 in total at the time of application; and
- provide evidence of:
 - a commitment to study; and
 - commitment to the environment
 - Applicants to provide evidence of Aboriginal heritage. You must be all of the following:
 - Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Australian descent;
 - identify as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Australian;
 - accepted as such by the community in which you live or have lived (letter of confirmation from community group (POA)/or acknowledgement from a key Aboriginal person from that community that you are accepted and identified as Aboriginal).

3 Administration of Scholarships:

- Shortlisting of eligible Scholarship Recipients will be conducted by a Selection Panel comprising at least three representatives from TAFE SA Staff;
- The Panel will assess shortlisted applicants and then forward recommendations to Veolia, who will approve Recipients to receive scholarships. Veolia's decision is final;
- TAFE SA will notify all applicants, in writing, of the outcome of their application;
- All information supplied to Panel Members, Counselling and Inclusion and Administration Officers and Veolia is treated as confidential;
- All signed Scholarship Applications will be an acceptance of the terms and conditions as set out by Veolia; including consent to their names and personal details being provided to Veolia for the purposes of distributing the Funds and possible invitation to social events, however, specific consent will be sought for any publicity which identifies individual Scholarship Recipients.

4 Conditions of Scholarship:

- Scholarships are paid in full as a single grant. The mode of payment is at the discretion of Veolia;
- Scholarship Recipients who discontinue study in their Eligible Course within 3 months of payment of a Scholarship, for whatever reason, will be required to return the Funds to Veolia upon the request of Veolia and in the amount specified by Veolia
